



Zins Invites You to "Sunday Supper for a Cause"

Join Zins on Sunday August 30, at 5PM for a special five-course dinner to help raise funds for Mission of Hope, a Cedar Rapids nonprofit.

Mission of Hope works to serve those in need by offering physical, emotional, and spiritual support, helping struggling individuals on a path to success and recovery.

Recently, a lack of funding threatened to disrupt Mission of Hope's programming. Although our community stepped up to help in a big way, they will need continued support to keep their programs running year-round.

To raise money for the charity, Zins patrons are invited to gather for a family style meal, with a menu created by Guest Chef Glenn Belfield. Dinner starts at \$60 per person, with diners encouraged to give more for the cause.

Zins will charge \$30 plus tax and gratuity for the meal, while the remainder will go to benefit Mission of Hope. The restaurant aims to raise at least \$1,000 for the local charity.

One: Charcuterie & Fromage

Two: Abbe Hills Farm "Potato" & Corn Chowder

Potato gnocchi, Berkwood farms bacon, roasted sweet corn and tomato, potato corn veloute

Three

Crispy Walleye, toasted farro, grilled summer squash, fresh garbanzo, cippolinis, basil gremolata, tomato nage brought to us by Dirty Faced Creek Farms

Four

Smoked Heritage Berkshire pork chop, caramelized nectarine and cherry, "creamed" corn polenta, black kale, bourbon glaze

Five

Caramelized figs, bananas, strawberries, vanilla angel food, salted caramel butterscotch, orange crema, milk chocolate, pistachio dust
